FCC Compliance Label



The FCC recently authorized the RIM radio option of the X-C 6250 for compliance with FCC regulations. Units which were manufactured prior to the new FCC approval are now required to have a new FCC compliance label installed. The new label is attached to this bulletin, and the instructions below show you where to place this label on the computer.

To attach the new FCC label

- Locate the 3-inch by 2-inch, silver product identification label on the bottom of the computer.
 A long rectangular box enclosing text runs across almost the entire length of the label and contains the FCC compliance statement. This is where the new label is to be applied.
- 2 Make sure the product identification label is clean and dry.

 If necessary the label can be cleaned with a solution of 1 part 409® and 1 part water.
- 3 Remove the label attached to this Technical Bulletin and remove the adhesive backing.
- 4 Make sure the label is aligned properly, and then press it into place.



IMPORTANT Read the accompanying Technical Bulletin on RF Antenna Placement. It contains important FCC compliance requirements for radio operators with regard to antenna placement.
