## **Cradle Contact Cable Assembly Replacement Procedure**


## **BellSouth Units Only**

Note: Considerations to prevent ESD damage to the cradle PCB components should be observed. Avoid contact with the cradle PCB and components.


Tools required: #1 Philips screw driver

## Procedure:


- 1. Ensure that power is disconnected from the cradle.
- 2. Remove the 14 screws that attach the cradle L base to the cradle case.
  - a) Remove the 6 screws from the back of the cradle.
  - b) Position the cradle so the bottom is face up and remove the 8 screws on the bottom.
  - c) Slide the L base toward the back of the cradle to allow the cradle PCB to clear the cradle case
- 3. Lift the L Base up slightly from the front (approximately 45 degrees) to allow access to the cable connection on the cradle PCB.
- 4. Grasp the top portion of the white connector (Cable to PCB [Male]) and press the locking tab to disconnect from the PCB.



5. Firmly grasp the brass coaxial connector and disconnect the coaxial cable from the cradle contact assembly.



- 6. The L base may now be lifted away from the rest of the cradle and set aside.
- 7. Remove the two screws and two washers holding the cradle contact assembly to the cradle case.
- 8. Remove the contact assembly by pushing it out through the top of the case.
- 9. Install the replacement cradle contact cable through top of the case.
- 10. The plastic portion of the cradle contact cable assembly is keyed and will only fit onto the cradle case holding tabs if it is in the correct orientation.



- 11. Position the cradle contact assembly and install the two screws and two washers that hold the cradle contact assembly to the cradle case.
- 12. Install the cradle contact cable connector onto the cradle PCB it is also keyed to connect in one orientation only. Ensure that the locking mechanism retains the connection.
- 13. Slide the L base onto the case from the rear to ensure that the power switch is in the correct position.
- 14. Re-install the 14 screws on the bottom and rear of the cradle.
- 15. Connect power to the cradle and verify unit charges after assembly (switch on/off and charging of X-C 6XXX, external RF connection). Ensure unit shows charger in battery status screen.

WARNING Use ESD precautions when replacing cradle parts. Tampering with the PCB in any way will void factory warranty.
