Product overview

DB2 Data Warehouse Edition (DWE) extends DB2 Enterprise with data warehousing and analytics inside the data server.

1 Step 1: Access your software


2 Step 2: Evaluate your hardware and system configuration

3 Step 3: Review the base architecture

DWE is a distributed product and its components are arranged into three logical groups, as shown in this diagram:



4 Step 4: Read the DB2 DWE Installation Guide

5 Step 5: Install the data warehouse server



This group includes DB2[®] Enterprise Server Edition Version 9.1, Query Patroller, Cube Views[™], Intelligent Miner[™], and Miningblox.

6 Step 6: Install the application server



This group includes WebSphere[®] Application Server, the DWE Administration Console, the SQL Warehousing Tool, and DB2 Alphablox. The Application Server requires either DB2 Enterprise or the DB2 Client to be installed for this group. If you do not install DB2 Enterprise, which is part of the Data Warehouse Server group, then the DB2 Client is installed.

7 Step 7: Install the client



This group includes the DWE Design Studio, the DB2 Client, Query Patroller, Intelligent Miner, and Miningblox.

8 Step 8: Install the documentation



You can install the DWE documentation, including the DWE Tutorial, on any Windows or Linux computer in your environment.

9 Step 9: Configure your environment



After running the DWE installation program, you need to perform a few tasks to get DWE up and running. See the DWE Installation Guide for more information.
